Course title: Safety and Sanitation

Course length: 150 hours

Description of the course: Safety, sanitation OSHA Regulations, MSDS/hazardous chemicals, decontamination and infection control.

Course Goals and Objectives:

Upon successful completion of this course, the graduate will be able to:

1. Qualify to take the Board of Cosmetology written exam on Safety and Sanitation OSHA Regulations, MSDS/hazardous chemicals, decontamination and infection control.
2. Know the safe and proper use of chemicals and products, how to prevent the spread of infection and disease. Prevention of contamination of tools, equipment and supplies.
3. Have an awareness of personal self worth, pride and professionalism.
4. Safely work with hazardous chemicals.

Course Format: Phagans' Educators present the material to the student by demonstrations, lectures, and student participation. The educator is supported by the use of textbooks, audio visual aids, videos, flip charts, games, white boards, and guest speakers. Safety & Sanitation is divided into four (4) units. The units are Pre-clinic/Freshman extension, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior. Each unit consists of academic, academic/lab and clinic lab.
